12	for veterans unable to meet the ordinary evidence re-
13	quirements for such a claim due to a major disaster;

17	(c) NOTICE TO VETERANS OF ELIGIBILITY FOR PRI-
18	ORITY CLAIMS PROCESSING.—Not later than 60 days
19	after the date of enactment of this Act, the Secretary shall
20	post a permanent notice to veterans on the Department
21	of Veterans Affairs website of the categories of eligibility
22	for priority processing of such claims, including the
23	changes to such categories made pursuant to subsection
24	(a).
