### Consular Services

Your country of origin may offer consular services for you, including help with renewing passports or some Deferred Action for Child Arrivals (DACA).

Under international law, consulates are protected locations that U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement will not enter.

Every county in CA-19 has resources for immigrants, including legal services and guides to social programs that are open to everyone, regardless of immigration status. Nobody will be reported to U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement simply for talking to a California government agency.
