I am requesting \$8 million in funding for the Martial Cottle Park Improvements project in Fiscal Year 2026. The entity to receive funding for this project is the County of Santa Clara, located at 70 West Hedding Street, 11th Floor, San Jose, CA, 95110. The funding would be used to implement phase one of the plan to preserve and upgrade the park site. This will include a combination of site and utility improvements, existing building/structure reuse, existing building/structure stabilization, and new building/structure construction.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because the project offers valuable opportunities for community engagement and education. By investing in the restoration and maintenance of historic buildings and structures, the project contributes to preserving local history and identity. Visitors can learn about agriculture, environmental stewardship, and local history through interpretive programs and interactive experiences, enriching the community's cultural and educational landscape. Furthermore, the development and enhancement of public parks and recreational facilities can stimulate local economies by attracting visitors, supporting tourism-related businesses, and creating job opportunities.
