I am requesting funding for the Canine Unit Expansion for Narcotics Detection in Jail Facilities project in Fiscal Year 2025. The entity to receive funding for this project the Santa Clara County Sheriff's Office located at 55 W. Younger Avenue, San Jose, CA 95110. The funding would enable the office to increase the number of jail narcotics detection canines to focus on detection efforts within the housing units, perimeter security fences, and mail rooms would greatly enhance the ability of the Sheriff's Office to maintain a safe environment for the incarcerated population and prevent the devastation and harm this epidemic is causing in our community.

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by section 501 of the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968 (34 U.S.C. § 10152).
